MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
JULY 3, 2000

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting July 3, 2000, at 7:00 P.M.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson, and Council Members present: Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood. Council Member Jimmy Mayfield was absent.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and presiding.

Johnny Cleveland led the Invocation.

Alicia Lawler, Representative from the Red Bay News, led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were Police Chief "Reb" Boatwright, and City Inspector Bob Hardin. Animal Control Officer Randoll Belue and Fire Chief Bud Strickland were absent.

Chief Reb Boatwright reported Debbie Benson has completed her basic telecommunication instructor's course. This now gives the department a basic telecommunication instructor and an emergency medical dispatcher instructor.

Amanda Harris, a resident of Village Green Apartments, asked the council for permission to have a road block on a Saturday for her 8 year old step sister, Kala Bailey, who is ill. Lowell Gober made a motion to grant the request of Amanda Harris, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

James Rogers discussed his concern on an Ordinance for mowing, and charge a license fee. Mayor Nelson had checked with the city attorney and mowing falls under free enterprise.

The total of pets receiving rabies shots were 139 dogs, and 18 cats.

Lowell Gober made a motion to approve a \$60.00 ad in the home football game program, seconded by Peggy Cox. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to enter into an AGREEMENT with James A. Norwood, Consultant, to secure grants for the city in the amount of \$1,000.00 per month, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

A report on the Family Fun Park concession building was given. All requirements has been met to satisfy the health department. The water slide should open next week.

Lowell Gober made a motion to grant SUMMIT, INC. Property Access Authorization to drill on 5th Ave old spur service station, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to buy an asphalt packer and a 62' sky lift in the amount of \$22,925.00 total to be purchased through the Equipment Fund, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to buy an ad in the Progress Addition of The Red Bay News, July 26, 2000, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to approve due bills, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve previous minutes of June 19, 2000, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. Unanimously passed.
