MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
JULY 17, 2000

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting July 17, 2000, at 7:00 p.m.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council members present: Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Mayor Nelson led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were Police Chief "Reb" Boatwright, City Inspector Bob Hardin, and Animal Control Randoll Belue. Fire Chief Bud Strickland was absent.

Chief "Reb" Boatwright reported to the council that three police officers would be graduating from a 13 week training Police Academy Friday, July 21, 2000. They are Sherri Hubbard, Scotty Chandler, and Scottie Belue.

A report was given by Mayor Nelson that we are approximately one month away from opening of the water slides.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to accept the 7.3% rate increase from the current rate submitted by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Alabama for medical and dental coverages, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

All requirements from the Franklin County Health Department on the concession stand at the Family Fun Park has been met.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, has been awarded the prestigious designation of "Certified Municipal Clerk" (CMC) from the International Institute of Municipal Clerks (IIMC) for achieving its high educational, experience, and service requirements.

Lowell Gober made a motion to pass RESOLUTION, Project No. ST-030-999-002, leveling and resurfacing streets in Miller Sub-Division, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to buy ½ page ad from Magnolia Graphics in the amount of \$574.00 with Water & Gas Board paying ½ of cost, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to table the request from Dorothy Davidson, representative of the Vina Rescue Squad, for \$100.00 donation.

Mayor Nelson introduced ORDINANCE #00-07-17B, Amend Ordinance #00-06-05A, to change poll hours from 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. All council members were in favor for immediate consent for consideration of adoption. Lowell Gober made a motion to adopt ORDINANCE #00-07-17B, seconded by Peggy Cox. Unanimously passed.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to adopt RESOLUTION #00-07-17A, Appointing Election Officers, Regular Election, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to adopt RESOLUTION #00-07-17, Appointing Election Officers, On-site ABSENTEE Voting, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Mayor Nelson received a letter from Senator Roger Bedford, Jr. stating that \$45,000.00 allocation for the Franklin County Board of Education was approved but will not be available until the end of October 2000.

Lowell Gober made a motion to pay due bills, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. All voted FOR except on Underwood True Value Bill, Eucellis Underwood ABSTAINED.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve previous minutes, July 3, 2000, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
