MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
NOVEMBER 20, 2000

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting **November 20, 2000**, at 7:00 P.M.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present: Peggy Cox, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood. Absent was Council Member Johnny Cleveland.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Jimmy Mayfield led the Invocation.

Mayor Nelson led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were Police Chief "Reb" Boatwright, Animal Control Officer Randoll Belue, and Fire Chief Bud Strickland.

The Mayor met with North Star Manger and agreed to keep traffic off the air and if they leave they are to notify the dispatcher when they go and come.

Stewart Wilson, Regional Sales Manager for Pond Doctor, met with the council at the last meeting concerning the lagoon. Peggy Cox made a motion to table any action toward the Pond Doctor due to the expense involved, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

A letter from Galaxy Cable Vision stated that effective January 1, 2002, the basic rate would be changed from \$27.95 to \$28.95 and show time from \$7.95 to \$8.95.

The quarterly inspection report on the landfill scales was good.

Sherri Hubbard resigned from the police department November 20, 2000.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to place Lynn Grissom over the water used on fires so a report can be compiled, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. Unanimously passed.

Mayor Nelson introduced ORDINANCE #00-11-20, adding a \$2.00 fee per traffic citation to provide additional funding for police equipment and operating capital for the drug fund. Upon Immediate consent for consideration on Ordinance #00-11-20, by roll call vote: Peggy Cox - "Yeas", Jimmy Mayfield - "Yeas", Lowell Gober - "Yeas", Eucellis Underwood - "Yeas", None - "Nays". Lowell Gober made a motion to adopt Ordinance #00-11-20, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. Voting by roll call: Peggy Cox - "Yeas", Jimmy Mayfield - "Yeas", Lowell Gober - "Yeas", and Eucellis Underwood - "Yeas", None - "Nays".

Peggy Cox made a motion to buy an ad in the Red Bay High School Yearbook provided Water & Gas pays ½ of cost, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to approve due bills, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve previous minutes of November 6, 2000, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
