MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
JUNE 18, 2001

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting **June 18, 2001**, at 7:00 p.m.

Present and presiding was Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present: Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Johnny Cleveland led the Invocation.

Jimmy Mayfield led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were Police Chief "Reb" Boatwright and Fire Chief Bud Strickland. City Inspector Bob Hardin was absent. Ericka Rogers, representative of Red Bay High School Band, was present.

Lowell Gober made a motion to accept request of Reb Boatwright to send Josh Garrison to the police academy August 29 thru November, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. Unanimously passed.

Reb Boatwright set Saturday, July 28, as Drug Awareness Day.

Bud Strickland requested that Scott Hamm be rehired on the fire department. Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to rehire Scott Hamm as a volunteer fireman, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Mayor Nelson asked Bud to study until next month about having a First Alert Group and a Second Alert Group.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to reject the request from Vina Rescue Squad, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

The Sewer Board met on June 12, 2001, and we failed to get a grant this year.

The water rate is going up because of the new 2.7 million dollar treatment plant. This will also effect the sewer rate because now the sewer rate is 60% of the water bill. The increase discussed was 1.5% per year. The drilling of the 3rd well is in process with expectation of 800 to 1100 gallons per minute.

The Tree Commission met June 13, 2001, to discuss dangerous trees or trees that are a liability to the city. If there is a problem or someone calls about a tree then a board member and Mayor will look at the tree and decide what needs to be done.

Peggy Cox made a motion to accept the decision of the Tree Commission about the trees, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Ericka Rogers requested a donation for the Red Bay High School Majorettes.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to donate \$300.00 to Red Bay High School Band, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to approve the MWPP Annual Report, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to pay due bills, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed, with the exception of Eucellis Underwood abstaining from Underwood True Value Hardware bill.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve minutes of June 14, 2001, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
