MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
AUGUST 6, 2001

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting August 6, 2001, at 7:00 p.m.

Present and presiding was Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present: Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood.

Jonni Gillette was present and recording in absent of City Clerk Shirley J. Cody.

Eli Cox, grandson of Council Member Peggy Cox, led the Invocation.

Emily Cox, grand-daughter of Council Member Peggy Cox, led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were Police Chief "Reb" Boatwright, City Inspector Bob Hardin, and Fire Chief Bud Strickland.

Chief "Reb" Boatwright reminded everyone that the Drug Awareness Fun Day is Saturday, August 11, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Jim Norwood held a public hearing about Red Bay applying for a grant to build an Outdoor Environmental Classroom to be located at the Intersection of Mud Creek and Little Bear Creek. The council unanimously agreed to apply for the Community Development Grant.

Lowell Gober made a motion to refuse the raise request from M. C. Funderburk for opening and closing a grave in the Red Bay City Cemetery, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to observe the new drug testing effective August 1, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to purchase a Back to School Safety Ad from the Red Bay News for \$75.00, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to appoint Chris Ginn to be the Safety Coordinator of the Fire Department, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Council agreed for a box be placed at the fire station for papers.

The Council unanimously favored Lynn Grissom to take care of paper work after a fire call or drill.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve ad and purchase t-shirts in the amount of \$248.50 to promote the City of Red Bay, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed. The shirts will appear with the gazebo from Bay Tree Park at the bottom, with the swimming pool in the background. The water slide coming down through the gazebo into a sign that says Red Bay, Alabama with Family Fun Park at top.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to pay due bills, seconded by Mayor Nelson. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve minutes of July 16, 2001, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Mayor Nelson. Unanimously passed.
