MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
SEPTEMBER 17, 2001

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting September 17, 2001 at 7:00 p.m.

Present and residing was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present: Peggy Cox, Jimmy Whitfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood. Council Member Johnny Cleveland was absent.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Eucellis Underwood led the Invocation.

Peggy Cox led the Allegiance to the Flag.

City Inspector Bob Hardin was present.

Mayor Nelson received a letter from State Senator Roger Bedford stating the \$25,000.00 has been approved for the Red Bay Police Equipment & Sport Complex grant.

All Weight Scales checked the scales at the landfill and they were good.

Recently there were two problems at the lagoon. The motors were pulled and fixed on the aerators and the curtain pulled loose. On September 12 a letter was written to the Alabama Department of Environmental Management stating the problems were corrected.

Red Bay Rescue requested \$600.00 for EMT class funding for 4 people @\$150.00 each. For lack of a motion the subject died.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to add Mutt Harrison, Ronnie Harrison, and Cully Cody to the volunteer fire department, seconded by Peggy Cox. Unanimously passed.

Alabama Department of Environmental Management Compliance Inspection Report showed on violations cited which made 8 months in a row with no violations.

Quinn Ranch Children Home is sponsoring a Fund Raiser Luncheon on November 17 at 7:00 p.m. at the A&E Building. Cost per table is \$200.00 or \$25.00 per plate. Peggy Cox made a motion to purchase 10 plates, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. Unanimously passed.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to give a cost of living raise effective week ending October 10, 2001, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to open a new account at Community Spirit Bank for the sidewalk project and for Mayor Nelson and Clerk Shirley J. Cody to sign official papers, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. All voted FOR except Peggy Cox, she ABSTAINED.

Lowell Gober made a motion to pay due bills, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve previous minutes, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
