MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
December 4, 2006

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting on December 4, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay Senior Citizens Building.

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council Members present were Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, and Ricky Holland.

Council Members absent were Bobby Nelson and Ann Wilkins.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were Fire Chief Bud Strickland, Police Chief Pat Creel, Police Lieutenant Eddie Chandler and Dispatcher Stephen Moore.

Ricky Holland led the Invocation.

Pat Hammock led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to purchase fire hoods, helmets, and gloves for eight fire suits, seconded by Ricky Holland. Unanimously passed.

Police Chief Pat Creel presented two awards for the year. Lt. Eddie Chandler received an award for the 2006 Officer of the Year. Stephen Moore received an award for the 2006 Dispatcher of the Year.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to stop transferring 10% (ten percent) of the monthly sales tax collections to the equipment fund. Ricky Holland seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

Pat Hammock made a motion to take sealed bids for a new sewer machine, Rayford Seahorn seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to transfer \$2500.00 per month from the occupational tax fund to the education fund for the remaining 10 months of the fiscal year, seconded by Pat Hammock. Unanimously passed. This is a total increase from \$20,000.00 per year to \$25,000.00 per year.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to enter into "**Executive Session**" to discuss good name and character. Ricky Holland seconded the motion. The roll call vote was as follows: Rayford Seahorn "yeas", Pat Hammock "yeas", and Ricky Holland "yeas". Mayor Jeff Reid announced that the time was 7:12 p.m. and that the council would return in approximately ten minutes. At 7:22 p.m. the mayor and council returned. Pat Hammock made a motion to return to "**Regular Session**", seconded by Ricky Holland. The roll call vote was as follows: Rayford Seahorn

“yeas”, Pat Hammock “yeas”, and Ricky Holland “yeas”. Mayor Jeff Reid announced that during “**Executive Session**” no votes were taken and no action was taken.

Mayor Jeff Reid announced that Buddy Scott had resigned from the Senior Citizen Board. This is a six-year term expiring October 1, 2009. Applicants must live in the city limits and can not be an officer or employee of the city. Anyone interested will need to sign the list posted at city hall.

Mayor Reid also announced that the next regular scheduled council meeting will be Monday, December 18, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. in the Red Bay Senior Citizen Building.


Rayford Seahorn made a motion to approve the bills, seconded by Ricky Holland. Unanimously passed.
