MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
 December 18, 2006

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting on December 18, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay Senior Citizens Building.

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council Members present were Bobby Nelson, Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins and Ricky Holland.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were Fire Chief Bud Strickland, Police Chief Pat Creel, and City Attorney Brian Hamilton.

Rev. Danny Fuller led the Invocation.

Pat Hammock led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Ricky Holland made a motion to appoint Martha Mitchell to the vacant position on the Senior Citizen Board. Bobby Nelson seconded the motion. Unanimously passed. The position was vacant due to the resignation of Buddy Scott. This is a six-year term expiring October 1, 2009.

Pat Hammock made a motion to take bids to purchase a one ton diesel truck to haul the sewer machine. Rayford Seahorn seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

Pat Hammock made a motion to transfer \$25,000.00 to the Education Fund per year instead of making a monthly transfer. The motion was seconded by Rayford Seahorn. Unanimously passed.

Mayor Jeff Reid opened sealed bids to purchase a vehicle to be used by city officials and city employees. Two bids were submitted:

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to accept the low bid of \$17,536.50 from Page Chevrolet, Inc., Ricky Holland seconded the motion. Voting **for** were Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins, and Ricky Holland. Voting **no** was Bobby Nelson.

Ricky Holland made a motion to enter into **Executive Session** for the purpose of discussing good name and character concerning agenda item #5 Senior Citizen Program. Rayford Seahorn

seconded the motion. The roll call vote was as follows: Bobby Nelson "yeas", Pat Hammock "yeas", Rayford Seahorn "yeas", Ann Wilkins "yeas" and Ricky Holland "yeas". Mayor Jeff Reid stated that the time was 7:08 p.m. and that the council would return in approximately 10 minutes.

At 7:15 p.m. the mayor and council returned. Mayor Jeff Reid stated that during Executive Session no action was taken and no votes were taken. Pat Hammock made a motion to return to Regular Session, Ann Wilkins seconded the motion. The roll call vote was as follows: Bobby Nelson "yeas", Rayford Seahorn "yeas", Pat Hammock "yeas", Ann Wilkins "yeas", and Ricky Holland "yeas".

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to adopt the 2006-2007 Budget, seconded by Ricky Holland. Unanimously passed.


Mayor Jeff Reid announced that citizens desiring to obtain copies of public records could do so by coming to city hall. The cost per copy is twenty-five cents.

The next regular scheduled council meeting will be Tuesday, January 2, 2007, 7:00 p.m. at the Red Bay Senior Citizen Building.


Rayford Seahorn made a motion to approve the bills, seconded by Ricky Holland. Unanimously passed.
