MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
September 4, 2007

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting on Tuesday, September 4, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4th Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council Members present were Bobby Nelson, Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins and Ricky Holland.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were Fire Chief Bud Strickland, Police Chief Pat Creel and T.H. Boyd.

Reverend Gary Puckett from the Church of God of Red Bay led the Invocation.

Ann Wilkins led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Fire Chief Bud Strickland reported that the 2007 fire grant applied for through the Federal Emergency Management Agency was not approved.

Police Chief Pat Creel requested permission to apply for a \$25,000.00 (twenty-five thousand dollar) equipment grant through the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA). If approved the grant would require a ten percent match from the City of Red Bay. Ricky Holland made a motion to allow Chief Creel to apply for the grant, seconded by Rayford Seahorn, unanimously passed.

Police Chief Pat Creel, speaking on behalf of Representative Johnny Mack Morrow, thanked the Mayor, Council and all other entities that made the Cyprus Cove Storytelling Event a reality. The event is being held in coordination with Red Bay's Centennial Celebration.

T.H.Boyd addressed the Council concerning a problem with his neighbor's dog.

Mayor Jeff Reid presented Business License Ordinance #07-08-20 for adoption. Rayford Seahorn made a motion to suspend with the reading of the ordinance at hand, seconded by Ricky Holland, unanimously passed. Mayor Jeff Reid announced that no one had signed up to be considered for the expired term on the Scope 310 Board.

Mayor Jeff Reid announced that he had appointed Rachel Boyd to serve on the Red Bay Planning Commission. This is a six-year term expiring May 29, 2011. Boyd is being appointed to the unexpired term of Rebecca Lockhart.

Pat Hammock made a motion to table appointments to the twelve board positions on the Little League Board, seconded by Rayford Seahorn, unanimously passed.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to use the county bid price for paving streets, seconded by Ricky Holland, unanimously passed.

Ricky Holland made a motion to reappoint Dorothy Harris to the Red Bay Sewage Board, seconded by Bobby Nelson, unanimously passed. This is a six-year term expiring October 4, 2013.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to reappoint Janet Wright to the Red Bay Senior Citizen Board, seconded by Ricky Holland, unanimously passed. This is a six-year term expiring October 1, 2013.

Mayor Jeff Reid made the following announcements:

1. The next regular scheduled council meeting will be Monday, September 17, 2007, 7:00 p.m., in the Red Bay City Hall, located at 203 4th Ave S.E
2. Red Bay's Centennial Celebration will be held on September 15, 2007.

Pat Hammock announced the Cyprus Cove Storytelling Event to be held on September 14 and 15, 2007.

Ann Wilkins announced a senior citizen fund raiser "Legends, Legacy, and Lace" to be held on September 15, 2007 at the Red Bay Arts and Entertainment Center.



Rayford Seahorn made a motion to approve the bills, seconded by Pat Hammock, unanimously passed.


Ricky Holland made a motion to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held August 20, 2007, seconded by Pat Hammock. Unanimously passed.
