MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
September 17, 2007

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting on Monday, September 17, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4th Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council Members present were Bobby Nelson, Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins and Ricky Holland.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were Fire Chief Bud Strickland.

Ricky Holland led the Invocation.

Pat Hammock led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Fire Chief Bud Strickland reported that at 7:25 a.m. on Sunday morning September 16, 2007 the 1984 Red GMC Fire Truck was reported to the police as having rolled into the office/storage facility of Community Spirit Bank located at the north west corner of 2nd St. West and 5th Ave. The truck was parked at the north east corner of 1st Street and 5th Ave. The truck was not parked in the Red Bay Fire Station due to items from the Centennial/Foundersfest Celebration being stored in the building. The emergency brake was applied to the truck and was found to be applied at the scene of the accident.

Police Chief Pat Creel was excused by the Mayor.

Ricky Holland made a motion to appoint Carly Hellums to the new term on the Scope 310 Board. This is a five-year term expiring September 2012. Bobby Nelson seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Ricky Holland made a motion to appoint the following applicants to the Little League Board. This is a one-year term expiring August 1, 2008:

Rayford Seahorn seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to table the proposed raise for city employees until the next meeting, seconded by Rayford Seahorn, unanimously passed.

Pat Hammock made a motion to contribute \$60,000.00 (sixty-thousand dollars) from the Red Bay Occupational Tax Fund to the Education Fund for the 07-08 year. The Education Fund will then reimburse the general fund for the 06-07 expenditures for the school in the amount of \$3734.45 (three thousand seven hundred and thirty-four 45/100). Rayford Seahorn seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to renew the yearly contract with Franklin County Chamber of Commerce for services to be rendered beginning October 1, 2007 and ending September 30, 2008. At a contract price of \$3500.00 (three thousand five hundred dollars). The amount is to be paid in four quarterly payments. The motion was seconded by Ricky Holland, unanimously passed.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to allow upright memorial markers to be placed in the portion of the Red Bay Cemetery gained from abandon railroad property. This section is enclosed in blocks #51, #52, and #53 according to the latest survey completed by Alexander Surveying and Mapping. Pat Hammock seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to have a sketch of the Red Bay Police Department, Red Bay City Hall, Red Bay Adult Life Center, and the Red Bay Weatherford Library included on the official City of Red Bay Flag, along with the sketch of the gazebo in Bay Tree Park and the bay tree. The motion was seconded by Pat Hammock, unanimously passed.

Ricky Holland made a motion to include the slogan "**Pride in our Past, Faith in our Future**" imprinted on the flag, seconded by Rayford Seahorn, unanimously passed.

Mayor Jeff Reid made the following announcements:

1. The next regular scheduled council meeting will be Monday, October 1, 2007, 7:00 p.m., in the Red Bay City Hall, located at 203 4th Ave S.E
2. Red Bay Education Committee – vacancy for the teacher representative position. Teachers of Red Bay School interested in this position are to come to city hall and sign the applicant list by 12:00 noon on September 26, 2007.

Pat Hammock made a motion to approve the bills, seconded by Rayford Seahorn, unanimously passed.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held September 4, 2007, seconded by Rayford Seahorn, unanimously passed.

Each council member commented on the success of the Red Bay Centennial Celebration held on September 15, 2007 and thanked all involved for their hard work. Chairperson Rosalyn Fabianke was commended for her leadership and for the success of the event.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Pat Hammock, unanimously passed.
