**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL**  
**January 7, 2008**

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting on Monday, January 7, 2008, 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council members present were Bobby Nelson, Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins and Ricky Holland.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were Fire Chief Bud Strickland, Police Chief Pat Creel, City Supervisor Wayne Sims, City Attorney Brian Hamilton, sewage employee Dennie Robinson, Sewage Engineer Rod Hawkins, Dixie Youth Officers Anthony Lindley and Anthony Pounds, and Regional Extension Agent for the AL Radon Education Program Patricia Smith.

Ricky Holland led the Invocation.

Pat Hammock led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Upon the request of Dixie Youth Officers Anthony Lindley and Anthony Pounds, Pat Hammock made a motion to purchase \$7,250.00 (seven thousand two hundred and fifty dollars) in materials to construct a storage facility at the Dixie Youth Complex on Edward Washington Waldrep Drive. Ricky Holland seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Patricia Smith, Regional Extension Agent for the AL Radon Education Program, presented all council members with a radon test kit. Mayor Jeff Reid signed a proclamation proclaiming January 2008 as Radon Awareness Month. Attachment A

Sewage Engineer Rod Hawkins and city sewage employee Dennie Robinson addressed the council concerning the ADEM two-year consent order that the City of Red Bay is presently under. The repairs and improvements to the lagoon and overall sewage system is estimated at this time to be between \$700,000.00 (seven hundred thousand dollars) and \$750,000.00 (seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars). USDA loans can be applied for that will cover thirty to forty-five percent of the gross amount needed. Ann Wilkins made a motion to apply for the loan, seconded by Pat Hammock, unanimously passed.

Ricky Holland made a motion to adopt Ordinance #07-12-17 Speed Limits, seconded by Rayford Seahorn, unanimously passed. Attachment **B**

The need for a new garbage truck was discussed at length.

Ricky Holland made a motion to upgrade the one hundred and eighty feet of wire fencing to be purchased for the skate park and the back side of the Hoyt Keeton Walking Trail from eleven and one half gauge wire to nine gauge wire for an overall cost of approximately three thousand four hundred dollars. The council voted at the December 17, 2007 meeting to fence the area at a cost of two thousand dollars. Pat Hammock seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Jeff Reid informed the council that Michael Lesly Adams employment with the City of Red Bay Police Department had been terminated. Ann Wilkins made a motion to enter into executive session for the reason of "good name and character". Bobby Nelson seconded the motion, the roll call vote was as follows: Bobby Nelson "yeas", Rayford Seahorn "yeas", Pat Hammock "yeas", Ann Wilkins "yeas", and Ricky Holland "yeas". Mayor Jeff Reid announced that the council would return in approximately ten minutes. The time was 7:19 p.m. At 7:35 p.m. the council returned. Bobby Nelson made a motion to return to regular session, seconded by Pat Hammock, the roll call vote was as follows: Bobby Nelson "yeas", Rayford Seahorn "yeas", Pat Hammock "yeas", Ann Wilkins "yeas", and Ricky Holland "yeas". Mayor Jeff Reid stated that during executive session no votes were taken, no action was taken, and no decisions were made.

Pat Hammock made a motion to reappoint Kelly Moore to another four-year term on the City of Red Bay Education Committee. Bobby Nelson seconded the motion, unanimously passed. This term will expire February 15, 2012.

Mayor Jeff Reid announced the next regular scheduled council meeting will be held Monday, January 21, 2008, 7:00 p.m. in the Red Bay City Hall, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave., Red Bay, AL

Pat Hammock made a motion to approve the bills for payment, seconded by Bobby Nelson, unanimously passed.


