MINUTES OF A REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING
RED BAY CITY COUNCIL
July 7, 2008

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting July 7, 2008, 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4th Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council members present were Bobby Nelson, David Martin, Pat Hammock and Ann Wilkins.

Council Member Ricky Holland was absent.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were Police Chief Pat Creel, and City Supervisor Wayne Sims.

Mayor Jeff Reid led the Invocation.

Pat Hammock led the Allegiance to the Flag.

The Council reviewed the list of persons desiring to be placed on the Zoning Board of Adjustment. The Board is a five member board with two supernumerary members. Each position is a three-year term. The original appointments to the board will be for staggered terms; after the staggered terms are completed the terms will then be three-year terms. Bobby Nelson made a motion to appoint Phillip Hammock and Herman Harrison to a one-year term each expiring July 7, 2009, James R. Winchester and Kristy Crandell to a two-year term expiring July 7, 2010, and Scotty Kennedy to a three-year term expiring July 7, 2011. Supernumerary members Paul R. Williams and Don Spencer each to a three-year term expiring July 7, 2011. David Martin seconded the motion, voting for were Bobby Nelson, David Martin, and Ann Wilkins. Pat Hammock abstained due to kinship. The motion carried.

Mayor Jeff Reid announced that the next regular scheduled council meeting will be Monday, July 21, 2008, 7:00 p.m., in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4th Avenue S.E., Red Bay, AL 35582.

The "Sunset in the Park" Ceremony commemorating the end of the centennial celebration for the City of Red Bay is scheduled for July 17, 2008, 7:30 p.m. The ceremony will be held in Bay Tree Park. A time capsule containing items from the Centennial Celebration as well as other Red Bay memorabilia will be buried. The capsule is scheduled to be exhumed in fifty years.

Pat Hammock made a motion to approve the bills for payment, seconded by Ann Wilkins, unanimously passed.


Pat Hammock made a motion to approve the workshop minutes and the council minutes for June 16, 2008, Bobby Nelson seconded the motion, unanimously passed.
