Present and presiding was Mayor Bobby Forsythe.

Council Members present were David Tiffin, Charlene Fancher, and Brad M. Bolton.

Council Member Mike Kennedy and Mike Stockton were absent.

Also present were City Attorney Senator Roger Bedford, Chief Janna Jackson, Fire Chief Bud Strickland, and Street and Sanitation Supervisor Wayne Sims.

Officer Mike Mayfield was present and acting as Sergeant at Arms.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

David Tiffin led the Invocation.

Charlene Fancher led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Debra Spillers and the Red Bay School Gifted Students gave an "Anti-Litter Presentation".

Charlene Fancher made a motion to hire Misty Hampton-Myrick as a part-time temporary seasonal at-will employee. David Tiffin second the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe made a motion to table hiring a part-time temporary employee for the street and sanitation department. Brad M. Bolton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Charlene Fancher made a motion to accept the 2008-2009 Audit as presented by Dicky Sparks CPA at the May 3, 2010 work session. Brad M. Bolton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Forsythe gave an update on the repair progress of the backhoe. Another backhoe may have to be purchased.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe made a motion to table the MWPP Resolution. Charlene Fancher seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Brad M. Bolton made a motion to approve bills for payment, seconded by Charlene Fancher. David Tiffin **abstained** from voting for bills due to Community Spirit Bank, Tiffin Supply, and City Automotive Parts, but voted to pay all other bills. Brad M. Bolton **abstained** from voting for bills due to Community Spirit Bank, but voted to pay all other bills. All bills were approved for payment.


David Tiffin made a motion to approve the minutes for the workshop and council meeting held May 3, 2010. Charlene Fancher seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe made the following announcements:


1. A 1997 Ford F450 Bucket Truck had been purchased for the City. Funds from the 2009 Debt Service were used to make the purchase.
2. MetroCast Cable Television will have all digital channels by the end of summer.
3. Three vendors have been contacted concerning the purchase of a sewage camera.
4. City Hall will be closed May 31 to observe Memorial Day.
5. The Farmers' Market will open June 1. Scheduled open days for the summer season are Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday.
6. The City of Red Bay Landfill was in compliance during the last state inspection.
7. "Prayer in the Park" is observed on the 1st Monday of each month. Everyone is encouraged to attend. "Prayer in the Park" was implemented the 1st Monday of December 2008 for the purpose of praying for the City and the officials of the City.
8. Congressman Robert Aderholt was in the City of Red Bay today.
