**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
RED BAY CITY COUNCIL
June 7, 2010
7:00 p.m.**

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting June 7, 2010, 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4th Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL.

Present and presiding was Mayor Bobby Forsythe.

Council Members present were Mike Kennedy, Mike Stockton, David Tiffin, Charlene Fancher, and Brad M. Bolton.

Also present were City Attorney Senator Roger Bedford, Police Chief Janna Jackson, Fire Chief Bud Strickland, and Street and Sanitation Supervisor Wayne Sims.

Police Chief Janna Jackson was acting as Sergeant at Arms.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Brad M. Bolton led the Invocation.

Mike Stockton led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Police Chief Janna Jackson announced that as of today the police department has an anonymous tip line. There is no caller identification for incoming calls and an answering machine answers all calls. Callers are asked to leave a message. The number for the new service is 256-356-3134.

Brad M. Bolton made a motion to table hiring a part-time street and sanitation employee. Mike Kennedy seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Forsythe addressed New Business Item No. 1 Discuss property for industrial development. The purpose for this item being placed on the agenda is to let the public know that the Mayor and the Council are working diligently to find property suitable for industrial development and to bring jobs to Red Bay.

David Tiffin made a motion to approve the written procurement policy for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG). Charlene Fancher seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mike Stockton made a motion for Senator Roger Bedford to investigate the City's legal possibility of contracting for dog catcher services and to review the City's present animal control and lease law ordinances.

The Mayor and Council discussed the need for a city building inspector.

Charlene Fancher made a motion to reappoint Kristy Crandell and James R. Winchester to another term on the Zoning board of Adjustment. Mike Stockton seconded the motion, unanimously passed. The new terms will expire July 7, 2013.

Jeremy Edgmon's ninety-day employment probation period will end June 15, 2010. David Tiffin made a motion to hire Edgmon as a full-time, at-will employee. Charlene Fancher seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mike Kennedy made a motion to approve the two Education Grant Funds Requests submitted by the Education Committee. Mike Stockton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Brad M. Bolton made a motion to grant a request submitted by the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation-UAB Birmingham, AL Local Research Chapter to hold a road block on Saturday, August 7, 2010. Charlene Fancher seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Brad M. Bolton made a motion to approve bills for payment, seconded by Charlene Fancher. David Tiffin **abstained** from voting for bills due to Community Spirit Bank, Tiffin Supply, and City Automotive Parts, but voted to pay all other bills. Brad M. Bolton **abstained** from voting for bills due to Community Spirit Bank, but voted to pay all other bills. All bills were approved for payment.


David Tiffin made a motion to approve the minutes for the workshop and council meeting held May 17, 2010. Charlene Fancher seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Charlene Fancher made a motion to approve the minutes for a called council meeting held May 25, 2010. Mike Kennedy seconded the motion, unanimously passed.


