MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING  
RED BAY CITY COUNCIL  
July 19, 2010  
7:00 p.m.

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting July 19, 2010, 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL.

Present and presiding was Mayor Bobby Forsythe.

Council Members present were Mike Kennedy, Mike Stockton, David Tiffin, Charlene Fancher, and Brad M. Bolton.

Also present were City Attorney Senator Roger Bedford, Police Chief Janna Jackson, Park and Recreation Director Joey Allen, Street and Sanitation Supervisor Wayne Sims, Fire Chief Bud Strickland, MetroCast Customer Care Manager Dave Von Dolteren, and MetroCast North Mississippi Director of Operations Jerry Morris.

Officer Terry Zills was present and acting as Sergeant at Arms.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Brad M. Bolton led the Invocation.

Charlene Fancher led the Allegiance to the Flag.

MetroCast Representatives Dave Von Dolteren and Jerry Morris addressed the Council concerning poor cable reception in the Red Bay Area. It was decided that MetroCast attorneys will contact City of Red Bay Attorney Senator Roger Bedford no later than Friday July 30, 2010.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe introduced Resolution #10-07-10A, a resolution defining the boundaries of the downtown area to be included in the CDBG 2010 Grant Application. Charlene Fancher made a motion to adopt the resolution, seconded by David Tiffin, unanimously passed. **Attachment A**

Mayor Bobby Forsythe introduced Resolution #10-07-19B, a resolution authorizing and approving application to the State of Alabama CDBG Planning Fund in the amount of thirty-two thousand dollars with an eight thousand dollar match from the City of Red Bay. Brad M. Bolton made a motion to adopt the resolution, seconded by Mike Kennedy, unanimously passed. **Attachment B**

Mayor Bobby Forsythe made a motion to table discussing the fireworks and firearms ordinance until a later date. David Tiffin seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe made a motion for the city attorney to review requests from the workmen's compensation carrier for new entries to the employee handbook. Mike Stockton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Due to the resignation of a part-time dispatcher, Charlene Fancher made a motion to take applications to fill the position until July 30, 2010, 4:00 p.m. Brad M. Bolton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Brad M. Bolton made a motion to appoint Chandler Bays to the Dixie Youth Board for a one-year term, expiring August 1, 2011. Charlene Fancher seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Charlene Fancher made a motion to appoint Jeremy Edgmon to the Dixie Youth Board for a one-year term, expiring August 1, 2011. David Tiffin seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mike Stockton made a motion to purchase a full-page advertisement in the 2010 Red Bay Quarterback Club Football Program at a cost of one hundred and twenty dollars. Mike Kennedy seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Brad M. Bolton made a motion to update the advertisement with necessary changes and to add a picture of the new school sign. Charlene Fancher seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Charlene Fancher made a motion to approve the bills, seconded by David Tiffin. David Tiffin **abstained** from voting for bills due to Community Spirit Bank, Tiffin Supply, and City Automotive Parts, but voted to pay all other bills. Brad M. Bolton **abstained** from voting for bills due to Community Spirit Bank, but voted to pay all other bills. All bills were approved for payment.


