MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
RED BAY CITY COUNCIL
August 2, 2010
7:00 p.m.

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting August 2, 2010 in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4th Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL. The meeting convened at 7:10 p.m.

Present and presiding was Mayor Bobby Forsythe.

Council Members present were Mike Kennedy, David Tiffin, Charlene Fancher, and Brad M. Bolton.

Council Member Mike Stockton was absent.

Also present were Park and Recreation Director Joey Allen, Street and Sanitation Supervisor Wayne Sims, and Fire Chief Bud Strickland.

Lieutenant Eddie Chandler was present and acting as Sergeant at Arms.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Mike Kennedy led the Invocation.

David Tiffin led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Mike Kennedy made a motion to table updating the Parks ad Recreation Department Outdoor Sports Complex Tournament & Rental Policies. Charlene Fancher seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Brad M. Bolton made a motion authorizing City Clerk Linda Holcomb to prepare a packet of information containing letters of complaint for the MetroCast Cable Service and a timeline of the contacts and promises made by representatives of that company. The packet will then be forwarded to MetroCast's home office in Frazier, Pennsylvania.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe made a motion to accept the city attorney's recommendations for workmen's compensation entries to the City of Red Bay Employee Handbook as written. The motion included using the present Council Police Board and Council Street and Sanitation Board instead of establishing a Central Accident Review Board. Brad M. Bolton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Charlene Fancher made a motion to table any action concerning the ordinance for fireworks and firearms. Mike Kennedy seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Forsythe informed the Council that the deadline for submitting application for the position of certified fulltime police officer and part-time police dispatcher had passed. The interview process will began August 10.

David Tiffin made a motion to approve the bills, seconded by Brad M. Bolton. David Tiffin **abstained** from voting for bills due to Community Spirit Bank, Tiffin Supply, and City Automotive Parts, but voted to pay all other bills. Brad M. Bolton **abstained** from voting for bills due to Community Spirit Bank, but voted to pay all other bills. All bills were approved for payment.


Charlene Fancher made a motion to approve minutes for a workshop and council meeting held July 19, 2010. Mike Kennedy seconded the motion, unanimously passed.


