**MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING**

The City Council of Red Bay met in a Called meeting January 3, 2011 in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL. The meeting convened at 1:05 p.m.

Present and presiding was Mayor Bobby Forsythe.

Council Members present were Mike Kennedy, Mike Stockton, David Tiffin, Charlene Fancher, and Brad M. Bolton.

Police Chief Janna Jackson and Street and Sanitation Supervisor Wayne Sims were present.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were representatives of Northstar Ambulance Service represented by Jeremy Glenn, Helen Keller Ambulance Service represented by Hospital Administrator Cary Payne, Vice President of Operations Kyle Buchanon, and Director of EMS Bruce Carson, Baccus Ambulance Service represented by Roy Baccus, Transcare Ambulance Service represented by Jeff Kemp, and Barry Pounders of Phil Campbell Rescue Squad.

Brad M. Bolton led the Invocation.

Charlene Fancher led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Mayor Forsythe stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the ambulance situation in Red Bay. NorthStar Ambulance Service will no longer have an office in Red Bay as of January 31, 2011.

Mayor Forsythe gave each Council Member a copy of Ordinance #99-01-21, an ordinance stating requirements for an ambulance service to purchase a privilege license in the City of Red Bay.

Numbers were drawn to decide which of the three ambulance services represented would speak first. The order the ambulance services addressed the Council is as follows:

1. Transcare, Belmont, Mississippi
2. Baccus Ambulance Service, Muscle Shoals, Alabama
3. Helen Keller Ambulance Service, Sheffield, Alabama


As each representative addressed the Council with their offered services to the City of Red Bay the other representatives courteously left the room.


