

ORDINANCE NO. 12-03-19

AN ORDINANCE TO EXEMPT CERTAIN "COVERED ITEMS" FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX DURING THE FIRST FULL WEEKEND OF AUGUST, 2012 AND EACH CONSECUTIVE YEAR THEREAFTER, AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT 2006-574 OF THE ALABAMA LEGISLATURE, GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS THE STATE SALES TAX HOLIDAY LEGISLATION

Be it **ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Red Bay, Alabama, as follows, to-wit:


SECTION 1. In conformity with the provisions of Action 2006-574 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2006 Regular Session providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday (Section 40-23-213, *Code of Alabama, 1975*), the City of Red Bay, Alabama, hereby exempts "covered items," as that term is defined in said statute, from municipal sales and use tax during the period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the first Friday in August and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday of each and every year, commencing August, 2012.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods and rules as provided by Act 2006-574.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Red Bay, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption and publication according to law.
