

ORDINANCE #96-06-03

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS AND PARKING REGULATIONS IN THE CITY OF RED BAY, ALABAMA, AND ITS POLICE JURISDICTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED BAY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1 ----- 50 mph

No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 50 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

4TH AVENUE on Alabama Highway 24 (4th Avenue) from 100 feet East of the intersection of Kennedy Street to the Easternmost city limits.

11TH STREET EAST from the Southernmost city limits Northernly to the intersection of Stadium Cut Off Road.

SECTION 2 ----- 45 mph

No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 45 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

11TH STREET EAST on Alabama Highway 19 from the intersection of Stadium Cut Off Road Northernly to the intersection of Alabama Highway 24 (4th Avenue).

4TH AVENUE on Alabama Highway 24 from the Mississippi State Line Northeasternly to 100 feet Southwest of the intersection of 7th Avenue South.

4TH AVENUE on Alabama Highway 24 from 100 feet East of Kennedy Street Westernly to the intersection of 10th Street East.

4TH STREET EAST (County Highway #11 South) from the intersection of Bethel Road north to the intersection of Bethel Road.

4TH STREET EAST (County Highway #11 North) from the intersection of Hospital Road South to the intersection of 10th Avenue North.

SECTION 3 ----- 40 mph

No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 40 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

4TH AVENUE on Alabama Highway 24 from the intersection of 10th Street East Westernly to

Pine Street.

4TH STREET EAST (County Highway #11 North) from the Northern-most city limit boundary at the Bear Creek Canal to 1,056 feet North of the intersection of Hospital Road and Highway #11 North;

AND

from the Southern-most city limit boundary (County Highway #11 South) to the intersection of Bethel Road.

OLD VINA ROAD (County Highway #9) from the Southeasternmost city limit boundary at Billy Stanphill Drive (County Highway #35) Northwesternly to the intersection of city landfill driveway.

SECTION 4 ----- 35 mph

No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 35 miles per hour in any zone of the city which are as follows:

4TH STREET WEST on Golden Road from the intersection of 6th Avenue North Northernly to the Northernmost city limits.

ALABAMA HIGHWAY #24 from 100 feet Southeast of the intersection of 7th Avenue South Northernly to 500 feet South of the intersection of 4th Avenue South.

BILLY STANPHILL DRIVE (County Highway #35) from the Easternmost city limit boundary to the intersection of Old Vina Road (County Highway #9)

NEWELL ROAD (County Highway #35) from the intersection of Bullen Drive to the intersection of Billy Stanphill Drive (County Highway #35).

COUNTY HIGHWAY #1 from the Southernmost city limit point northernly to the intersection of 9th Street West (Old Waterplant Road).

SECTION 5 ----- 30 mph

No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 30 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

1ST STREET from intersection of 3rd Avenue South to the intersection of 7th Avenue South.

2ND STREET WEST from the intersection of 3rd Avenue South to the intersection of 7th Avenue South.

3RD AVENUE SOUTH from the intersection of 4th Street West (Golden Road) to intersection of 6th Street West.

3RD AVENUE SOUTH from intersection of 1st Street West to the intersection of 3rd Street West.

3RD STREET EAST from the intersection of 4th Avenue South (State Highway #24) to the intersection of 7th Avenue South.

3RD STREET WEST from the intersection of 3rd Avenue South to the intersection of 7th Avenue South.

4TH STREET WEST on Golden Road from the intersection of Alabama Highway 24 Northernly to the intersection of 6th Avenue North.

4TH AVENUE SOUTH on Alabama Highway #24 from 7th Street West Easternly through the central business district to the intersection of Pine Street.

4TH STREET WEST (Golden Road) at intersection of 4th Avenue South (State Highway #24) to intersection of 7th Avenue South.

5TH AVENUE SOUTH from intersection of 4th Street West to intersection of 3rd Street East.

5TH STREET EAST from intersection of 6th Avenue North to intersection of 10th Avenue North; Housing Units.

5TH STREET EAST from intersection of 4th Avenue South (State Highway # 24) to intersection of 7th Avenue South.

HOSPITAL ROAD in its' entirety, from Golden Road to the intersection of #11 North.

MAGNOLIA STREET in its' entirety, beginning at the intersection of 9th Street West (Waterplant Road also known as County Highway #1) to the Alabama/Mississippi State Line.

WOODLAND DRIVE in its' entirety, beginning at the intersection of 11th Street East (State Highway #19 and #172) to dead-end.

HUNTERS ROAD in its' entirety, beginning at the intersection of 11th Street East (State Highway #19 and #172) to dead-end.

SECTION 6 ----- 25 mph

No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 25 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

2ND STREET WEST from the intersection of 6th Avenue North to the intersection of 10th Avenue North; Public Parking Area.

3RD AVENUE SOUTH from intersection of 6th Street West to the intersection of 7th Street West, because of Daycare Center.

4TH AVENUE SOUTH on Alabama Highway #24 from 500 feet South of 4th Avenue South North and Eastern to the intersection of 7th Street West.

4TH STREET EAST (County Highway #11 North) from intersection of 4th Avenue South (State Highway #24) to intersection of 2nd Avenue North.

4TH STREET EAST (Highway #11 South) from the intersection of Stadium Street Northernly to the intersection of 7th Avenue South.

5TH COURT CIRCLE in its' entirety, from the intersection of 5th Street East; Housing Units.

6TH AVENUE NORTH from the intersection of 4th Street West (Golden Road) eastwardly to the intersection of 4th Street East (County Highway #11 North).

6TH STREET WEST from intersection of 3rd Avenue South to the intersection of 2nd Avenue South, because of Daycare Center.

7TH AVENUE SOUTH beginning at intersection of 5th Street West to the intersection of 4th Avenue South.

8TH AVENUE EAST from the intersection of 4th Avenue South (State Highway #24) North to the intersection of 2nd Avenue North and 2nd Avenue North from the intersection of 8th Avenue East traveling west to the intersection of 4th Street East (County Highway #11 North).

8TH STREET EAST beginning at intersection of 7th Avenue South to the intersection of 7th Street East.

9TH STREET EAST in its' entirety, from the intersection of 4th Avenue South (State Highway #24) to dead-end.

11TH AVENUE EAST from intersection of 8th Avenue East to intersection of 10th Street East; Extreme narrow street.

ARMSTRONG DRIVE entire circle, beginning and ending at intersection of Old Vina Road.

BOSTICK ROAD beginning 793 feet South of intersection of 4th Avenue South (State Highway #24) to intersection of 10th Street East; Daycare Center.

BRADLEY STREET in its' entirety, beginning at the intersection of 4th Street East (County Highway #11 South) to dead-end.

BULLARD DRIVE entire circle, beginning and ending at intersection of Old Vina Road (County Highway #9).

COPELAND CIRCLE in its' entirety, beginning and ending at intersection of 11th Street East (State Highway #19 and #172). This is a one-way street traveling east.

EDWARD WASHINGTON WALDREP DRIVE in its' entirety from intersection of Bullen Drive to dead-end. Public Park Area.

EUGENIA NIXON CIRCLE in its' entirety, from the intersection of 2nd Street West; Housing Units.

ROGERS RD
~~PHILLER ROAD~~ from the intersection of 5th Street East in its' entirety.

HOSPITAL ROAD from intersection of Country Club Drive to intersection of Redmont Drive; Hospital Zone.

LEE AVENUE AND SCOTT DRIVE in its' entireties.

NORTH STREET (off of Hester Avenue) to dead-end.

PINE STREET in its' entirety, from the intersection of 4th Avenue South (Highway #24) to dead-end.

SANDILOULANE in its' entirety, from the intersection of Sheree Drive to dead-end.

SHEREE DRIVE AND DAVIS DRIVE from the intersection of 8th Avenue East in the entirety to the intersection of 5th Street East.

SUNNY STREET in its' entirety, from the intersection of 10th Avenue North to dead-end.

VALLEY ROAD in its' entirety, beginning at intersection of Old Vina Road (County Highway #9) to dead-end.

WILLOW STREET in its' entirety, from the intersection of 2nd Avenue North to dead-end.

WINNIE FROST DRIVE in its' entirety, from intersection of 4th Avenue South (State Highway #24) to intersection of 10th Street East; Cemetery.

SECTION 7 ----- 20 mph

No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 20 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

2ND STREET WEST from intersection of 3rd Avenue South to intersection of 6th Avenue North; industrial zone.

7TH STREET WEST from intersection of 4th Avenue South (State Highway #24) North to dead-end at Sunshine Homes; industrial zone.

BATES DRIVE from the intersection of 9th Street West easternly in its' entirety, to dead-end.

DOGWOOD DRIVE in its' entirety, beginning at the intersection of 7th Avenue South to dead-end.

DOGWOOD DRIVE (Highway #11 South) at the intersection of 4th Street East in its' entirety to the dead-end.

EDGEWOOD DRIVE in its' entirety, from the intersection of Gober Drive to dead-end.

GOBER DRIVE in its' entirety, beginning at intersection of 7th Avenue South to dead-end.

NADINE DRIVE in its' entirety, beginning at the intersection of 4th Street East (County Highway #11 South) to dead-end.

PIONEER ROAD from the intersection of 4th Street East (County Highway #11 South) in its' entirety.

SETTLEMENT ROAD from the intersection of 9th Street West in its' entirety.

SUNSHINE AVENUE in its' entirety, from the intersection of 7th Street West to dead-end; industrial zone.

SECTION 8 ----- 15 mph

No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 15 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

7TH STREET EAST in its' entirety; School zone.

8TH AVENUE SOUTH (Collum Street) in its' entirety, from the intersection of 4th Street East (County Highway #11 South) to dead-end.

8TH STREET EAST beginning at the intersection of 7th Street East to intersection of Stadium Street; School Zone.

9TH AVENUE SOUTH in its' entirety, beginning at intersection of 4th Street East (County Highway #11 South) to intersection of 7th Street East; School Zone.

CARL STREET in its' entirety, from the intersection of 6th Avenue North to dead-end; Housing Units.

EPPS CIRCLE in its' entirety, from the intersection of Hospital Road to dead-end, extreme short street.

SECTION 10. No person shall park a motor vehicle in any designated area for longer than any period of time as designated by proper signage as marked.

SECTION 11. In addition to all other provisions of law relating to speed and operation of motor vehicles in said city, there is hereby adopted by the City of Red Bay, Alabama, all laws of the State of Alabama and all rules and regulations of the Alabama Highway Department pertaining to the control of traffic and motor vehicles on highways, that are misdemeanors under the State laws and a violation of such laws, rules, and regulations in the City of Red Bay or in the police jurisdiction thereof shall be violations of this ordinance.

SECTION 12. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable under the laws of the State of Alabama, by fine, imprisonment, hard labor, license revocation or a combination thereof of any or all punishments, and the punishments herein may change from time to time as State Laws change which applies hereto to this ordinance. It is the purpose of this section to always comply with existing State Laws of the State of Alabama as they may change in the future.

SECTION 13. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, namely Ordinance #92-4-6D.

SECTION 14. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication as provided by laws.
