

ORDINANCE NO 00-08-21

Be it ordained as follows by the City Council of the City of Red Bay, Alabama:

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bay is procuring a loan with Community Spirit Bank in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00). This Ordinance is being adopted to amend Ordinance No. 97-06-19 and 97-06-19A, and;

WHEREAS, it is specifically found that the loan is in the best interest of the City in order to provide operating capital for the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained as follows by the City Council of the City of Red Bay, Alabama:

1. That any and all monies not used from the proceeds from the taxes referred to in Ordinance No. 89-1-20 and Ordinance No. 68-6 to retire any indebtedness owed by the City under a warrant and/or bond issue shall be pledged to satisfy the Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) indebtedness referred to herein.

2. That the Mayor of the City of Red Bay, Alabama, Tommy G. Nelson, and the City Clerk, Shirley Cody, be and are hereby authorized to execute all documents on behalf of the City, and to take any and all other steps necessary in the name of the City to effectuate said loan;

3. That a copy of this ordinance be spread upon the minutes of the City Council, and published in a newspaper of local

circulation and posted as required by law.

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
SEPTEMBER 18, 2000

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting September 18, 2000, at 7:00 P.M.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present: Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Mayor Nelson led the Invocation.

Jimmy Mayfield led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were Police Chief "Reb" Boatwright, City Inspector Bob Hardin, and Animal Control Officer Randoll Belue. Fire Chief Bud Strickland was absent. Also present were Tim Reid, Franklin Co. Extension System, Karen James, Representative of the Red Bay School, Junior High Cheerleaders and two representatives from AIR-EVAC LIFETEAM.

Fun Day at the Family Park was a success with approximately 250 kids attending and approximately 400 people over all.

Peggy Cox made a motion to donate \$1,000.00 FY 2000-2001, to Franklin County Extension System, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Karen James on behalf of the Junior High Cheerleaders requested either the Mayor or a City Council Member present the trophies at the Founder's Day Pageant, October 14, 2000, at the school. The request was granted.

Representatives from AIR-EVAC LIFETEAM presented a slide to show the importance of a few precious seconds in a life or death situation. They ask for membership and support from the city. No action was taken but will discuss later.

The city will save \$600.00 per year by changing to Floweb Internet Website.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to enter into a CONTRACT FOR SERVICES OCTOBER 2000 TO SEPTEMBER 2001 with the Franklin County Chamber of Commerce in the amount of \$4800.00 per year, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion for the Mayor and Council to attend the League Annual Convention May 19-22, 2001, seconded by Peggy Cox. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion for the Red Bay Dispatchers to receive and dispatch 911 calls effective October 9th, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to accept the raises for Fiscal Year 2000-2001 for city employees, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to purchase a 1977 Ford, F100 Ranger Pickup from Danny Maxwell. The motor will be installed in present landfill truck, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

The city maps are in and delivery will begin today.

U. S. Senator Jeff Sessions wrote a letter thanking the City of Red Bay for the warm hospitality during his recent visit.

Mayor Nelson introduced ORDINANCE #00-08-21, \$500,000.00 Loan, Amend Ordinance #97-06-19, and 97-06-19A, To provide operating capital for the city. Upon immediate consent for consideration on Ordinance #00-08-21, by roll call vote: Peggy Cox "Yeas", Johnny Cleveland "Yeas", Jimmy Mayfield "Yeas", Lowell Gober "Yeas", and Eucellis Underwood "Yeas", None - "Nays". Lowell Gober made a motion to adopt ORDINANCE #00-08-21, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Voting by roll call: Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood - "Yeas", None - "Nays".




